

NEWS UPDATE

We began this year in anticipation of completing the acquisition of the shop by the society, which of course eventually occurred in March. As 2021 draws to a close, we are pleased to advise that we have now reached another important milestone.

The pandemic continued to have an impact on our progress throughout the year, but nevertheless we have continued to work hard with various parties to move forward with the redevelopment plan and were able to submit a pre-application to the Scottish Borders Council in early October. Based on the initial feedback we received, we have worked with our architect to refine our plan and we are pleased to report that our formal planning application was submitted on December 17th. We know that the application review and approval process can sometimes be quite lengthy, but in anticipation of a successful outcome we have engaged a quantity surveyor to develop costings for our plan before commencing a tender for the works, which is a requirement under the terms of the grant we were awarded from the Scottish Government's Regeneration Capital Grant Fund. We will be very busy in the New Year to move the refurbishment project along.
